



Snow Glass Candle Jar

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Supplies List:

- **My Digital Studio:** My Digital Studio Software (#118108), Snow Digital Brush Stamp (#128881)
- **Ink:** Real Red (My Digital Studio Color Palette)
- **Paper:** Silver Glimmer Paper (#124005), Add a Little Dazzle Transfer Sheets (purchase at www.addalittledazzle.com)
- **Accessories:** Rhinestone Jewels (#119246), Rhinestone Brads (#113144), 5/8" Real Red Satin Ribbon (#117286), Brayer (#102395), Paper Cutter (#104152), Big Shot (#113439), Northern Frost Decorative Strip (#120901), Decorative Strip Cutting Pads (#113479), Decorative Strip Spacer Platform (#113477)
- **Non-SU:** Paper Stump, Glass Candle Jar, Silver Wine Charm Hoops

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Dimensions:

- Transfer Sheet 8 ½" x 11" (1 sheet)
- Silver Glimmer Paper: 2" x 2" (1 piece)
- 5/8" Real Red Satin Ribbon: 30" (1 piece)

Directions for Snow Glass Candle Jar:

Step 1 Open the My Digital Studio Program. Select Multiple Output Options in the New Project Options Window. Choose the 8 ½" x 11" Portrait Option and choose Create Your Own Template. Label your project "Snow Candle Wrap".

Step 2 Find the Resource Palette located in the left hand column and choose stamps. Choose Snow from the stamp category and click OPEN. The Snow Image will now appear in the left hand column of your screen. Double Click on the image and it will insert it into your page.

Step 3 Go to the Design Center found in the right hand column of your screen, choose stamps, and click on rotate 90 degree left, resize the image to fit your sheet from top to bottom. If you are going to make more than one image, then add the desired images at this time.

Step 4 Go back to the Design Center found in the right hand column of your screen and choose stamps. Click on Mirror Image and reverse all the images you will be printing. Choose the Change Color Option and color in your image in Real Red.

Step 5 Set the Printer Resolution to high and Paper Option to Photo Paper. Insert the Transfer Film into the printer. Make sure the image is printed on the Matte Side of the sheet.

Step 6 Cut out the image into a 3 ¼" x 11" piece and cut out a matching Adhesive Film piece (a separate sheet with a glossy side).

Step 7 Place your printed piece with the Matte Side facing up, peel the white liner from the Adhesive Film, and apply Glossy Sticky piece to the image (matte side up). Go over the piece with a Brayer to ensure it is attached.

Step 8 Use your Paper Cutter to clean up any sides that have adhesive hanging over. Peel the Glossy Film at the edge, attach the image to the glass jar, and rub over it with a Paper Stump OR Brayer to make sure you do not leave any bubbles. Continue pulling back a small section of Glossy Film from the Transfer Sheet and rub over it to remove the bubbles. Continue this process until the entire Adhesive Sheet is attached to the glass jar.

Step 9 Take Rhinestone Jewels and attach to the image where there are Snowflakes and dots. Spread them out sporadically. Take the 5/8" Real Red Satin Ribbon, wrap it around the neck of the candle jar, tie in a bow, and cut off excess.

Step 10 Take the 2 ½" x 2 ½" piece of Silver Glimmer Paper, place it on the Northern Frost Decorative Strip, and run it through the Big Shot back and forth 4 times. Place a Rhinestone Brad through the center, run a Wine Hoop through one of the holes of the snowflake, and attach the snowflake to the bow.
