## Supplies List:

- Paper: Real Red Cardstock (#102482), Pretty in Pink Cardstock (#100459), Scarlet Red Metal Sheet & Hot Pink Diamond Metal Sheets (purchase at <u>www.addalittledazzle.com</u>)
- Accessories: Sticky Strip (#104294), Paper Snips (#103579), Paper Cutter (#104152), Simply Scored Scoring Tool (#122334), Hearts Collection Framelits Dies (#125599), Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder (#120175), Big Shot (#113439)


## **Dimensions:**

- Real Red Cardstock: 3" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (2 pieces)
- Scarlet Red Metal Sheet: 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (4 pieces)
- Pretty in Pink Cardstock: 3" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (2 pieces)
- Hot Pink Diamond Metal Sheet: 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (4 pieces)

## **Directions for Hearts Framelits Metal Embossed Mini Luminaria:**

**Step 1** Take a 3" X 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" piece of Real Red Cardstock, align it along the upper left hand corner of the Simply Scored Scoring Tool, and score at 3" and 6". Follow this same step for the second piece.

**Step 2** Take a Cutting Pad and place it on top of a closed Multipurpose Platform (Tab 2). Take the 3" x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of Real Red Cardstock, fold it in half with the small flap facing the left hand side (hanging out). Center the 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Scarlet Red Metal Sheet on top of the 3"x 3" section facing the top. Place the assembled piece on the Cutting Pad, center & place the 2<sup>nd</sup> layered Framelit Heart in the center of the piece (ridge side down). Place the second Cutting Pad on top, and run it through the Big Shot twice (back and forth). Remove the center heart from the Scarlet Red Metal Sheet and Real Red Cardstock.



**Step 3** Take the piece cut in Step 2 and lay it open flat with the small flap facing the left hand side. Place the second coordinating piece directly underneath, place the Framelit Heart (ridge side down) on one of the heart openings, and follow the directions from Step 2 to create the heart window. After you have created the first opening, place the Heart Framelit on the second heart window, and run it through the Big Shot. Both 3" x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces will now have even heart windows.

**Step 4** Take the three  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces of Scarlet Red Metal Sheet, place them underneath the first metal piece cut in Step 2, follow the directions in Step 2, and run it through the Big Shot. You will now have four  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces of Scarlet Red Metal Sheet. Place the Scarlet Red Metal Sheet piece inside the Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder and run it through the Big Shot. Place Sticky Strip along the four walls of the piece and around the heart, peel the red film, align with the heart on the cardstock, and attach.

**Step 5** Place two pieces of Sticky Strip along the outside  $\frac{1}{2}$ " flap of each piece, peel the red film, and assemble the luminaria. The flaps will be on the inside of the luminaria where it isn't visible. Place Votive Candle Holder and candle in the luminaria. It is ready to be lit.

Note: Hot Pink Diamond Metal Sheet with Pretty in Pink Cardstock is shown on the right hand side.
