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
#### **Dimensions:**

- Very Vanilla Cardstock: 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (1 piece), 2" x 2" (1 piece)
- Real Red Cardstock: 3" x 6" (1 piece)
- Scarlet Red Metal Sheet: 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (1 piece)
- Add a Little Dazzle Transfer Sheet: 8 1/2" x 11"
- 1/2" Very Vanilla Seam Binding: 16" (1 piece)

## Directions for P.S. I Love You Metal Embossed Mini Card:

**Step 1** Take a 3" X 6" piece of Real Red Cardstock, align it along the upper left hand corner of the Simply Scored Scoring Tool, and score at 3".


**Step 2** Take a Cutting Pad and place it on top of a closed Multipurpose Platform (Tab 2). Take the 3" x 6" piece of Real Red Cardstock, place it on the Cutting Pad, place a  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Scarlet Red Metal Sheet on top of the Real Red piece (as shown below), and center & place the  $2^{nd}$  layered Framelit Heart in the center of the two pieces (ridge side down). Place the second Cutting Pad on top, and run it through the Big Shot twice (back and forth). Remove the center heart from the Scarlet Red Metal Sheet and Real Red Cardstock.



**Step 3** Take a Paper Stump and go over the rim of the heart on the Scarlet Red Metal Sheet piece to remove the ridge.

**Step 4** Place the Scarlet Red Metal Sheet piece inside the Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder and run it through the Big Shot. Place Sticky Strip along the four walls of the piece and around the heart, peel the red film, align with the heart on the cardstock, and attach.

**Step 5** Open the card (as shown below) and cut a small slit with an Exacto Knife.



**Step 6** Run the Very Vanilla Seam Binding through the slot, tie in a bow around the front of the card, and cut off excess.

**Step 7** Ink the Love Stamp with Real Red Classic Ink and stamp the sentiment on a 2" x 2" piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock. Take the Jewelry Tag Punch and punch out the piece. Distress the edges with Real Red Classic Ink. Punch a hole with the Handheld Circle Punch, run a Wine Charm, and attach the tag. Place a Mini Glue Dot on the back of the Jewelry Tag to hold it in place on the front of the card. Run Snail Adhesive along the back of the 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock and attach it to the inside of the card.

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### Instructions for My Digital Studio Image:

**Step 1** Open the My Digital Studio Program and select Multiple Output Options, choose the 8 ½" x 11" Portrait Option, and choose Create Your Own.

Step 2 Name your project and click OK.

**Step 3** Go to the Resource Palette found in the left hand column and choose Stamps. Click Browse, look for P.S. I Love You, and open the stamp set.

**Step 4** Find the heart image and double click on it. Once the image is in the document resize it to the following: x: 1.502 and y:1.338. Move the image to the top of the page, go to the Resource Section in the right hand column, and change the color of the image to Real Red or Cherry Cobbler. Fill the page with as many of the images of the heart as you like.

**Step 5** Click the "Print Button", save the file, set the Printer Resolution to high and Paper Option to Photo Paper. Insert the Transfer Film into the printer. Make sure the image is printed on the Matte Side of the sheet and print the image. **Note: If you are using an Inkjet Printer allow the printed image to dry before handling.** 

**Step 6** Cut out the image into a small piece and cut out a matching Adhesive Film piece (a separate sheet with a glossy side). Place your printed piece with the Matte Side facing up, peel the white liner from the Adhesive Film, and apply Glossy Sticky piece to the image (matte side up). Go over the piece with a Popsicle Stick to ensure it is attached.

**Step 7** Cut out the image right along the outside of the heart shape. Do not leave extra film around the edges. Keep card closed, peel the Glossy Film at the edge, and attach the heart through the opening. Rub over it with a Popsicle Stick to make sure you do not leave any bubbles. Continue this process until the entire Adhesive Sheet is attached to the cardstock and remove top film.

Step 8 You are done!

# **Tips for Add a Little Dazzle Transfer Sheets**

- 1. Use images that are full of graphics. Do not choose images with lots of empty space.
- 2. Choose an image you can cut around easily to avoid the "halo effect".
- 3. Follow instructions carefully.
