



Flower Folds Metal Embossed Tea Light Holders

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Supplies List

- **Paper:** Rose Red Cardstock (#102544), Hot Pink Diamond Metal Sheets (purchase at www.addalittledazzle.com)
- **Accessories:** Sticky Sheets (#114300), Paper Cutter (#104152), Big Shot (#113439), Flower Folds Bigz XL Die Cut (#115970), Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder (#120175), Extended Cutting Pad (#113478), Designer Sanding Blocks (#124304)
- **Non-SU:** Hot Glue Gun, Tea Light Candles

Dimensions:

- Rose Red Cardstock: 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" (1 piece), 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" (1 piece), 3 ½" x 3 ½" (1 piece), 3" x 3" (1 piece)
- Sticky Sheets: 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" (1 piece), 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" (1 piece), 3 ½" x 3 ½" (1 piece), 3" x 3" (1 piece)
- Hot Pink Diamond Metal Sheet: 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" (1 piece), 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" (1 piece), 3 ½" x 3 ½" (1 piece), 3" x 3" (1 piece)

Instructions for Flower Folds Metal Embossed Tea Light Holder:

Step 1 Take the 5 ¼" square of Sticky Sheet and attach it to the 5 ¼" piece of Rose Red Cardstock. Then, peel the red film from the Sticky Sheet and attach the 5 ¼" square of Hot Pink Diamond Metal Sheet to it. Follow this same step for the 4 ¼", 3 ½", and 3" square pieces. You will have 4 assembled pieces.

Step 2 Take the 5 ¼" assembled square piece, place it face down on the largest flower on the Flower Folds Bigz Die, place the Extended Cutting Pad on top, and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 3 Take the 4 ¼" assembled square piece and place it on the next size down flower, place the Extended Cutting Pad on top, and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 4 Take the 3 ½" assembled square piece, place it on the next size down flower, place the Extended Cutting Pad on top, and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 5 Take the 3" assembled square piece, place it on the smallest flower, place the Extended Cutting Pad on top, and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 6 Take each flower (one at a time), place it inside the Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder, and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 7 Take the Sanding Block and sand in a circular motion over each piece. Go over each sanded flower with a Microfiber Cloth to remove the metal residue.

Step 8 Assemble the flower by placing the largest flower on a flat surface. Apply some Hot Glue Gun to the center of the flower and place the next smallest flower on top it. Make sure to overlap the flower petals. Continue assembling the flower until you have finished. **Note: Due to having cardstock and Sticky Page attached to the metal, the heat will not conduct through the metal and burn you.**

Step 9 Take the assembled Flower Fold Tea Light Holder and bring down the bottom petals to create your base. Continue shaping the rest of the petals to your liking. Place the tea light or battery operated tea light in the center. You are done!
