- Paper: Sycamore Street Designer Series Paper (#127540), Crumb Cake Card Stock (#120953), Very Vanilla Cardstock (#101650), Brushed Bronze Metal Sheets, Rustic Red Metal Sheets (purchase at www.addalittledazzle.com)
- Accessories: Big Shot (#113439), 1/16" Circle Punch (#101227), 1 ¼" Circle Punch (#119861), 1 3/8" Circle Punch (#119860), Elegant Butterfly Punch (#127526), Lacy Brocade Impressions Folder (#127819), Basic Pearls Jewels (#119247), Stampin' Sponges (#101610), Crumb Cake ½" Seam Binding (#122332), Sticky Strip (#104294), Snail Adhesive (#104332), Stampin' Dimensionals (#104430), Cellophane Bags 4" x 6" (#102757), Stampin' Trimmer (#126889), Bone Folder (#102300), Crystal Effects (#101055)

Dimensions:

- Sycamore Street Designer Series Paper Stack: 1 7/8" square (4 pieces)
- Crumb Cake Card Stock: 5" x 8 ½" (1 piece), 2" x 4" (1 piece)
- Very Vanilla Card Stock: 2 ½" square (1 piece), 1" x 2" (1 piece)
- Brushed Bronze Metal Sheet: 2 ½" square (1 piece)
- Rustic Red Metal Sheet: 3" square (1piece)

Instructions for Chocolate Dipped Marshmallow: Sycamore Street Designer Series Paper:

Step 1 Take a pack of Wilton Candy and melt it as stated on the package. Meanwhile, place wax paper on a cookie sheet and run a lollipop stick through each Jumbo Marshmallow. Place crushed toffee in a small bowl.

Step 2 Once the chocolate candy has melted, place each marshmallow in it and twirl it until the entire marshmallow is covered in chocolate. Let excess chocolate drip off and place the marshmallow on the wax paper. Once you have done this for all your marshmallows, place it in the refrigerator until it begins to harden, but it is still soft enough to cover with crushed toffee. Once you have covered the marshmallows with toffee, place it back in the refrigerator until completely hardened. Then, place each marshmallow stick on a gold cupcake liner.

Step 3 Score the 2" x 4" piece of Crumb Cake Card Stock at 2" on the 4" side. Attach the 1 7/8" pieces of designer series paper on both sides of the piece with Snail Adhesive.

Step 4 Take the 4" x 6" Cellophane Bag, place it on the Stampin' Trimmer, and score at 1" on all the closed sides. Go over the scored areas with a Bone Folder.

Step 5 Take a 5" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sheet of Crumb Cake Card Stock and score at 2", 4", 6", and 8" on the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side. Run Snail Adhesive along the $\frac{1}{2}$ " flap and assemble the piece.



Step 6 Place this piece inside the cellophane bag. Stop when it reaches the 1" score mark on the bottom of the piece.



Step 7 Shape each flap as shown in the picture and place Sticky Strip on them.



Step 8 Attach the flaps as shown in the picture and place the Bone Folder inside the bag to ensure it is secured. Pull out the card stock piece and you have your bag.



Step 9 Take the 2" x 4" assembled piece, run Snail Adhesive along back and attach to the inside of your bag. Place the assembled Chocolate Dipped Marshmallow inside the bag and tie with a piece of ½" Crumb Cake Seam Binding.

Step 10 Take the Very Vanilla Card Stock and punch out a 1 3/8" circle. Emboss the **Brushed Bronze Metal Sheet** piece with the Lacy Brocade Impressions Folder and punch out a 1 1/4" circle. Place Stampin' Dimensionals along the back of the Brushed Bronze piece and attach it to the center of the Very Vanilla Card Stock circle. Use the 1/16" Circle Handheld Punch and punch a hole in the Very Vanilla Card Stock Circle. Run a Wine Charm through the hole and attach to the bow.

Step 11 Emboss the 3" square piece of *Rustic Red Metal Sheet* and punch out a butterfly with the butterfly punch. Place Stampin' Dimensionals along the back and attach to the card front. Attach pearls with Crystal Effects. Stamp the sentiment on the 1" x 2" piece of Very Vanilla Card Stock, cut it out, distress the edges, and attach to the tag with Sticky Strip.
