Supplies List

- *Paper:* Pucker Me Pink Metal Sheet (purchase at <u>www.addalittledazzle.com</u>)
- *Accessories:* Big Shot (#113439), Lacy Brocade Impressions Folder (#127819), ¼" Wide Scor-Tape, Stampin' Trimmer (#126889), Bone Folder (#102300), Medium Envelopes (#107301), Crystal Effects (#101055), Craft & Rubber Scissors (#103179), Paper Snips (#103579)

Dimensions:

- Medium White Envelopes: (2 envelopes)
- Pucker Me Pink Metal Sheet: 4" x 5 1/2" (1 piece)

Instructions for How to Make an Envelope Liner Using Metal Sheets:

Step 1 Take an envelope and use the Stampin' Trimmer to cut off ¹/₄" off each the left and right hand side of the envelope.

Step 2 Cut off the gummed area off the envelope flap. Cut 2" off the bottom section of your template. Trace this template onto an Add a Little Dazzle Metal Sheet and cut it out.

Step 3 Take an uncut envelope and align the right side of the metal sheet along the right side of the envelope flap. Make sure the top of the metal sheet lines up with the envelope flap and cut off the little bit of excess from the flap. Then, do the same thing for the left hand side of the metal sheet. This allows you to curve the ends of the envelope flap.

Step 4 Emboss the Add a Little Dazzle Metal Sheet with the Lacy Brocade Impressions Folder.

Step 5 Place Sticky Strip along the outside walls of the metal embossed envelope liner.

Step 6 Without removing the Scor-Tape, place the metal embossed liner inside the envelope and position it where you want it. Then, take a pencil and make a small mark on each side of the metal where the fold of the envelope is. Place a piece of Scor-Tape on that fold, BUT don't go over those two marks.

Step 7 Peel the Scor-Tape from the fold on the flap and the Add a Little Dazzle Metal Sheet and attach it to the inside of the envelope flap.
