## Dimensions:

- So Saffron Cardstock: 4 ¼" x 11" (1 piece)
- Very Vanilla Cardstock: 4" x 5 ¼" (1 piece), 1 ½" x 3" (1 piece)
- Outrageously Orange Metal Sheet: 2 ½" x 2 ½" (1 piece), 2" x 2 ½" (1 piece)
- Metal Foil Tape Sheet: 4 ½" x 4 ½" ( 1 piece)
- Sticky Sheet: 2" x 2 ½" (1 piece)

## Instructions for He Is Risen Metal Embossed Butterfly Card:

**Step 1** Take the 4 ¼" x 11" sheet of So Saffron Cardstock, line up the 11" side along the top of the paper cutter, and score at 5 ½".

**Step 2** Ink the Décor Standard Wheel with Versa Mark Ink and wheel it over the card front.

**Step 3** Take the 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of **Metal Foil Tape Sheet**, place it aluminum side down on the Paper Doily Large Sizzlits Die, and place the piece on the cutting pad. The Multipurpose Platform should be open to Tab 1, place the assembled piece on top, and then place the second cutting mat on top and run it through the Big Shot.

**Step 4** Use the Paper Piercing Tool to remove all small pieces from the doily. Peel the White Film off the back of the Doily Metal Foil Tape Sheet piece, attach to the center of the card, and go over it with a Brayer.

**Step 5** Take the 2" x 2 ½" piece of **Outrageously Orange Metal Sheet**, attach the piece of Sticky Sheet to the back, place it inside the Beautiful Butterflies Die Cut (metal sheet color side down), and run it through the Big Shot. Emboss the butterfly with the Impressions Folder of choice, peel the red film, and attach it to the front of the card.

**Step 6** Take the 2 ½" square of **Outrageously Orange Metal Sheet**, place it inside the Beautiful Wings Sizzlits, and run it through the Big Shot. Take the large butterfly, lightly sand it, and attach it on top of the bigger butterfly with Hot Glue.

**Step 7** Take the smaller butterflies and attach two of them on top of each other with Hot Glue and attach to the card front with Hot Glue. Take a toothpick, apply drops of Crystal Effects to the center of the butterfly, and attach the pearls. Follow the same step for the small butterflies.

**Step 8** Take the 1 ½" x 3" piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock, run it through the Big Shot with the corresponding tag, and stamp the sentiment with Pumpkin Pie Classic Ink. Place Stampin' Dimensionals along the back and attach to the card front.

**Step 9** Place pearls along the outside of the doily and inside openings as desired.

**Step 10** Stamp the Very Vanilla Cardstock piece in More Mustard for the flower image and Pumpkin Pie for the sentiment. Run Snail Adhesive along the back and attach to the inside of the card.
