



Stampin' Up! Fabric Pin Cushion

Supplies List

- **Fabric:** Timeless Portrait Fabric (#122337)
- **Paper:** Scarlet Red Craft Metal Sheets (purchase at www.addalittledazzle.com)
- **Accessories:** Big Shot (#113439), Dress Up Framelits Dies (#130101), Perfect Polka Dots Impressions Folder (#117335), Crumb Cake ½" Seam Binding (#122332), Artisan Embellishments Kit (#129328)
- **Non SU:** Hot Glue Gun, Filling, Picture Frame, Acrylic Paint, Glossy Spray Paint Sealer, Magnetic Sheets (local store)

Dimensions:

- Timeless Portrait Fabric: 8"square
- Scarlet Red Craft Metal Sheet: 2" x 5" (1 piece)
- Magnetic Sheet: 2" x 5" (1 piece)
- Crumb Cake ½" Seam Binding: 6" (1 piece)
- Flower Button: 1 piece

Instructions for Stampin' Up! Fabric Pin Cushion:

Step 1 Use spray paint or acrylic paint to color your frame in the color of choice. After it is dry, spray with a clear glossy finish. Let it dry.

Step 2 Cut out a piece of fabric that is 2 times the size of the opening of the frame. **Example: The opening of my frame is 4" x 4"; therefore, I am going to cut my fabric into an 8" x 8" piece.**



Step 3 Remove the back and the glass from the frame and place the fabric over the top. Make sure that the front of the fabric is facing out.



Step 4 Stuff a portion of filling into the frame.



Step 5 Fold the excess fabric over the cardboard and secure the back of the frame with the back piece that came with the frame.

Step 6 Take a 2" x 5" piece of magnetic sheet, peel the white film, and attach the 2" x 5" piece of Scarlet Red Craft Metal Sheet to it.



Step 7 Place the Dress Up Framelit on top of the assembled piece and run it through the Big Shot. You may need to run it through 2-3 times and carefully remove. Note: You are using the magnetic sheet to create a strong backing for the metal sheet.

Step 8 Place the piece in the Perfect Polka Dots Impressions Folder and run it through the Big Shot.



Step 9 Wrap a piece of Crumb Cake 1/2" Seam Binding around the piece, tie in a knot, and attach the flower with Hot Glue.

Step 10 Place Hot Glue on the back of the assembled piece and attach to the side of the pin cushion frame.
