Supplies List

- **Paper:** Elegant Eggplant Cardstock (#105126), Island Indigo Cardstock (#122932), Crumb Cake Cardstock (#120953), Plum Metal Sheets, Bronzed God Metal Sheets, Peacock Metal Sheets (purchase at www.addalittledazzle.com)
- **Accessories:** Flower Folds Bigz XL Die (#115970), Extended Cutting Pads (#113478), Big Shot (#113439), Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder (#120175), Paper Cutter (#104152), Sanding Block (#124304), Sticky Page (#114300), Stampin' Dimensionals (#104430), Snail Adhesive (#104332)
- **Non-Stampin' Up!:** Jumbo Paper Clips, Microfiber Cloth, E-6000 Glue, Flattened Bottle Caps & Mirrors (www.addalittledazzle.com)

Dimensions:

- **Elegant Eggplant, Island Indigo, and Crumb Cake Cardstock:**
 - ◆ 3 ½" x 3 ½" (2 pieces), 3" x 3" (1 piece)
- **Plum, Bronze God, and Peacock Metal Sheet: 3 ½" x 3 ½" (2 pieces), 3" x 3" (1 piece)**
- **Sticky Page: 3 ½" x 3 ½" (3 pieces), 3" x 3" (1 piece)**

Instructions for Flower Folds Jumbo Paper Clip Bookmark:

Step 1 Take the 3 ½" x 3 ½" piece of Elegant Eggplant Cardstock, Sticky Page, Plum Metal Sheet, and attach them to each other. Place the assembled piece on the corresponding flower and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 2 Take the 3" x 3" piece of Elegant Eggplant Cardstock, Sticky Page, Plum Metal Sheet, and attach them to each other. Place the assembled piece on the corresponding flower and run it through the Big Shot.

Step 3 Take the remaining 3 ½" x 3 ½" piece of Elegant Eggplant Cardstock, Sticky Page, Plum Metal Sheet, and attach them to each other. Take the piece and run it through the Big Shot using the same flower used in **Step 1**.

Step 4 Take the 3 ½" x 3 ½" piece of Sticky Page and run it through the same flower used in **Step 1**.

Step 5 Run all the pieces **(except the piece in Step 4)** through the Big Shot using the Vintage Wallpaper Impressions Folder. Sand all the pieces with the Sanding Block (circular motion) and remove the residue with a Microfiber Cloth.

Step 6 Take the piece cut in **Step 4** and attach it to the cardstock side of one of the bigger flowers. Peel the red film, place the Jumbo Paper Clip in the center, and attach the other big flower on top. Press down the edges and in the center to secure the flowers.

Step 7 Take the smaller flower, place Stampin' Dimensionals along the back, peel the white film, and attach to the center of the larger flower.

Step 8 Squeeze some E-6000 Glue in the center of the flower, place the Bottle Cap in the center, and press down.

Step 9 Squeeze some E-6000 Glue in the center of the bottle cap and place the mirror in the center. Allow the piece to dry.

Step 10 You are done!
